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**DAY 01 - NOV 4, THU: DEPART USA**

Tour members meet in Atlanta for our non-stop flight to Tel Aviv. After take-off, we will be served meals according to flight schedule.

**DAY 02 - NOV 5, FRI: ARRIVE TEL AVIV**

We arrive in Tel Aviv where we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motorcoach for our short drive to Netanya where we'll have dinner and overnight along the shores of the Mediterranean.

**DAY 03 - NOV 6, SAT: NETANYA, CAESAREA MARITIMA, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, NAZARETH, CANA**

After an enjoyable Israeli buffet breakfast, we begin today's sightseeing which includes the following biblical sites: **Caesarea Maritima** (Acts 9 & 25), **Tel Megiddo**, **Mt. Carmel** with time for devotions (1 Kgs. 18), from here we have short drive to **Druze Village** for a lunch break, afterwards continue to **Nazareth** (Luke 1 & 2), a short drive takes us through the town of **Cana** (John 2); **Zipori**, and then we make our way to our Tiberias hotel located on the shores of the **Sea of Galilee**, for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 04 - NOV 7, SUN: GALILEE, MT. OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, BOAT RIDE ON SEA OF GALILEE, CAPERNAUM, JORDAN RIVER**

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise in the Galilee from our hotel. We begin our sightseeing with our first stop visit at the **Mt. of Beatitudes** (Matt. 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. From here we make our way to **Caper-naum**, We then board our replica wooden **Jesus Boat** for our Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee, we then stop for a special traditional St. Peter's Fish lunch. Afterwards we see **Gadera** and then make our way to the **River Jordan**. We return to our hotel in time for dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

**DAY 05 - NOV 8, MON: GOLAN HEIGHTS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, BEIT SHEAN, JERUSALEM**

After breakfast we travel north for the Golan Heights and view the area from a special lookout. From here we continue our drive to **Caesarea Philippi**, where we will have time for devotion; afterwards we have a short hike/walk to **Tel Dan** where we will see the gate of Jeroboam. From here we will include a visit to **Gideon Springs**. Afterwards, time permitting we end our days sightseeing with a visit to **Tel Beit Shean**, one of the best preserved Decapolis Roman cities. We make our way up to majestic city of Jerusalem in time for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 06 - NOV 9, TUE: SHRINE OF THE BOOK, MODEL CITY, HEZEKIAH'S SHAFT, ST. PETER GALLICANTU, GARDEN TOMB**

After breakfast we begin our sightseeing with a short drive to the **Shrine of the Book Museum**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed, then you will be fascinated by your visit to a **Model of Jerusalem** (1 to 50 scale model of Herodian Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time), afterwards we drive to **Hezekiah's Shaft** for a visit (please be sure to bring good water shoes with you, as you will get wet walking through the tunnel, also be sure to bring a flashlight with you if at possible). We then make our way to the **Church of Agony** at **St. Peter Gallicantu**. Afterwards we make our way to the **Garden Tomb** for time of worship and communion. We conclude our day with a farewell dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 07 - NOV 10, WED: MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, MT. ZION GATE, JEWISH QUARTER, TEMPLE MOUNT, SOUTHERN STEPS, BETHLEHEM, YAD VASHEM**

We begin our explorations with a drive to the beautiful **Mt. of Olives** to behold the breathtaking panorama of the **Holy City**. Our pilgrimage will proceed down the **Old Palm Sunday Road** to



the **Garden of Gethsemane** with its ancient olive grove, and there visit the **Church of Agony**, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will enter Jerusalem through the **Zion Gate**, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the **Western Wall (Wailing Wall)** of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35 acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Sam. 24:18-25). On this site now stands the magnificent **Dome of the Rock** (the third holiest shrine in all Islam) and the **El-Aksa Mosque**. From the temple area, we make our way to **St. Stephen's Gate**, **St. Anne's Crusader Church**, **Pools of Bethesda**, the **Sister of Zion Convent** (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), **Ecco Homo Arch**, and the ancient **Cardo**.

We continue to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Afterwards a short walk takes us to the **Southern Steps** to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. We conclude our sightseeing with a short drive and visit to **Bethlehem**, we will pass by **Rachel's Tomb** on the outskirts of Bethlehem, and visit the **Church of the Nativity** and **Shepherd's Field**. From here we drive to **Yad Vashem**, Jewish Holocaust Memorial for a visit prior to returning to Jerusalem in time for dinner and our overnight. After dinner we make our way back to the **Western Wall** for a visit to the **Rabbi's Tunnel**.

**DAY 08 - NOV 11, THU: EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, MASADA, DEAD SEA-SWIM/FLOAT**

After our breakfast, we begin our day of sightseeing with a visit to **Ein Gedi** where David hid from King Saul. From here we make our way to **Qumran** and the possible settlement of the first century sect known as the **Essenes**, the authors of the **Dead Sea Scrolls**. Following the road south along the western shore of the **Dead Sea**, we will stop and visit **Masada**, where we will ascend high upon the wilderness mountain by way of the cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces. Time permitting,

we will make a special stop at the **Dead Sea** (also referred to as the lowest spot on the earth) for a **short swim/float** (please be sure you bring with you good water/closed end shoes, as the bottom surface can be rough on your feet). Afterwards we make our way back to Jerusalem. The road from the **Dead Sea** area to Jerusalem is an ascent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. If time permits we'll include a short visit to **Jericho** (time & conditions permitting). Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 09 - NOV 12, FRI, TUE: JERUSALEM**

Today is without a planned program. Time to collect your thoughts; indulge your whims. Revisit the places of most interest. The **Rockefeller and Hebrew Museums** display a wealth of archeological treasure. Return for a last look within the walls of the **Old City** where bargaining is a must. Farewell Dinner and late evening transfer to **Ben Gurion Airport** for our evening flight back home.

**DAY 10 - NOV 13, SAT, WED: ARRIVE BACK IN U.S.A.**

We arrive back in the USA late morning. The close of an unforgettable tour, we bring with us lasting memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life and ministry of our Lord.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms/cabins are often smaller than doubles.
